The First 100 Days

Our mission is to establish the staffing, connection of resources, drafting of initial policies, identifying which existing policies are a priority to co-author, working with district advisory boards to create an equity agenda and audit plan, and creating oversight and accountability within state budget priorities.

The first ten (10) days will consist of hiring executive staff in both Sacramento and San Diego, creating a constituent services plan, and establishment of office, operations, and issues of greatest importance. We will utilize connections with and access to key stakeholders and public officials to get to work on day one.

Community and Constituent Engagement

1. Establish the 79th district advisory board with members reflective of the district from each city and community.
2. The creation of a youth advisory board that is reflective of the diverse makeup of the district and includes disabled/neurodiverse individuals.
3. Within the advisory boards we will be identifying short-term, mid-term, and long-term goals, district goals vs statewide goals.

Prioritizing Policy

4. Draft of priority policies.
5. Evaluation of existing policies to co-author.
6. Pushing to pass existing policies and advocating for policies that align with priority issues.

California COVID-19 Rescue and Recovery

7. Working with federal and local public officials to connect resources to the district.
8. Identifying state funded resources to create equity in education and reopen schools.
9. Contracting with community-led programs to provide case management services, to connect resources to constituents and communities.
10. Business advocacy representatives to connect state-funded small business loans and grants to small business owners and entrepreneurs, prioritizing BIPOC business owners.
11. Addressing lack of access to internet, transportation, testing, and vaccinations.

Implementation and roll out of my Economic Development Plan for the 79th Assembly District.

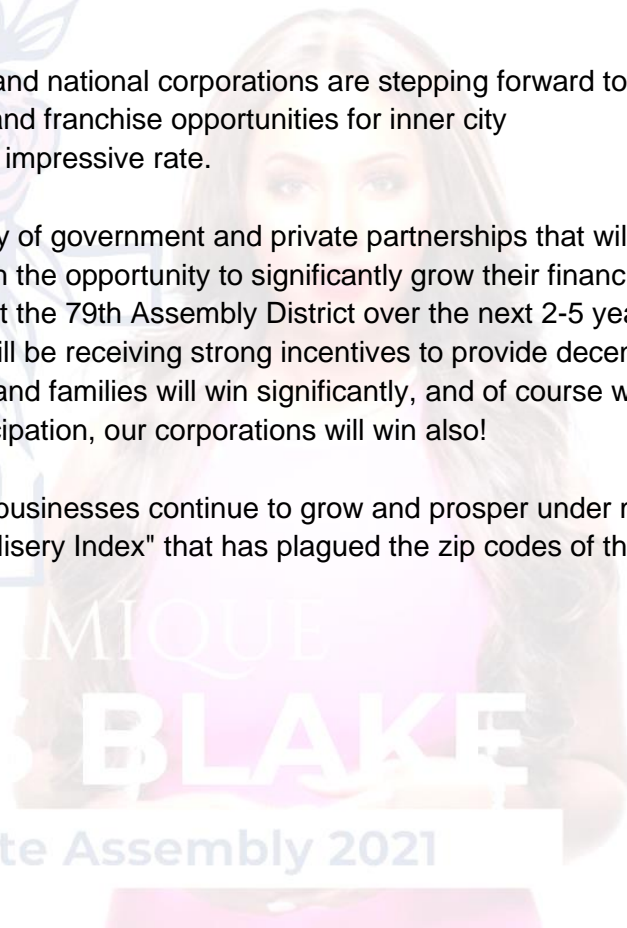
